# PLAYING THE GAME

Introducing Double Down Madness™ Blackjack, the ultimate twist to the traditional game of blackjack. Each player receives one card initially and can double down to boost payouts. No splitting or surrendering is allowed, and the dealer hits soft 17. Double Down Madness Blackjack also offers the optional Push 22 bonus wager.

## GETTING STARTED

Place the mandatory wager in the betting circle, and optionally the Push 22 side wager. The first card of the round is dealt to the dealer face-up and then each player receives 1 card face-up. Once each player receives one card, the dealer will receive their second card face down. Insurance is offered if the dealer's up card is an Ace. If the dealer has blackjack, all wagers lose, and no second card is dealt.

## DECISIONS

You have three choices:

1. **Stand:** Maintain the current hand value AFTER receiving a second card.
2. **Hit:** Request an additional card.
3. **Double Down:** Double the initial/previous wager(s).

## HITTING & DOUBLING DOWN

You may hit and double down with each card you receive until you decide to stand or your hand busts. When doubling down, you can match up to the amount already in play.

## PLAYER ACE

If your initial starting card is an Ace, you will only receive one card, whether you hit or double.

## BLACKJACK

If you double down and receive a blackjack on your first two cards, you will receive the posted blackjack odds for both the main wager and double-down amount.

## PUSH 22

If the dealer has a point total of 22, any main wagers and doubles will push. The Push 22 side bet wins if the dealer has a point total of 22; otherwise, it loses.

**Note:** Player blackjacks are paid before the dealer hits out their hand, so they are exempt from the Push 22 rule.

**PLAYERS'EDGE** Must be 21 years of age or older to gamble unless otherwise noted. Must be 18 years of age or older in Florida to participate in Bingo and Poker. Must be 18 years of age or older in the Dominican Republic. Must be 19 years of age or older in the Province of Ontario, Canada.
