PLAYING THE GAME

Free Bet Blackjack lets you double down and split for free.

If you choose the Free Bet options, the dealer will place a special lammer next to your original wager. If you win the hand, you are paid as if you had made a traditional split or double, even though you did not put any additional money at risk.

GETTING STARTED

Make a bet to play against the dealer. You and the dealer will get two starting cards, as in standard blackjack.

FREE SPLIT

You may free-split any pairs except for 10-value cards. Free re-splitting is allowed.

Aces may be Free Split once and will receive one card each Ace, as in traditional Blackjack.

FREE DOUBLE

You may free double any hard 9, 10, or 11. Free doubling after splitting is allowed.

PUSH 22

If the dealer busts with a point total of 22, any bets you have left in action are pushes.

Optional side wager PUSH 22, if offered, wins if the dealer busts with a point total of 22 and is paid 11 to 1.

Note: Player blackjacks are exempt from the Push 22 rule.
