


HOW TO PLAY MISSISSIPPI STUD PROGRESSIVE

PLAYING THE GAME

Mississippi Stud is a five-card poker game where you compete against a payable, not against the Dealer, and you win if your hand is a pair of Jacks or better. Mississippi Stud also features the optional 3-Card Bonus and progressive wagers.

GETTING STARTED

Make an Ante bet to receive your first two cards. You may also make the progressive and 3 Card Bonus wagers. The Dealer will place three community cards face down in the middle of the layout.

PLAY OR FOLD?

At this point, you may either fold or make the 3rd street bet of 1x, 2x or 3x your Ante. The Dealer then reveals the first community card, you have a choice: fold or make the 4th street bet of 1x, 2x or 3x your Ante. The Dealer then reveals the second community card. Once again, you can fold or stay in the game by making the 5th street bet from 1x, 2x or 3x your Ante.

Note: When you fold, your Ante and any additional main game bets placed are forfeited. The three-card bonus bet remains in action until the three community cards are exposed.

WINNING AND LOSING

After the Dealer turns over the final community card, all remaining wagers are resolved. You win if your five-card hand is a pair of jacks or better (pairs of 6s-10s push). See payable for odds.

3-CARD BONUS WAGER

The 3-Card Bonus pays if the three community cards contain a pair or better. See payable for odds.

PROGRESSIVE PAYOUTS

The progressive bet qualifies you for payouts from the progressive jackpot. See payable for odds.

PLAYERSEDGE Must be 21 years of age or older to gamble unless otherwise noted. Must be 18 years of age or older in Florida to participate in Bingo and Poker. Must be 18 years of age or older in the Dominican Republic. Must be 19 years of age or older in the Province of Ontario, Canada.
