

HOW TO PLAY ONE CARD BLACKJACK

PLAYING THE GAME

The object of One Card Blackjack is to achieve a higher card count than the Dealer without exceeding a total of 11.

TO PLAY AGAINST THE DEALER

Make a bet in the designated area. The King, Queen and Jack count as ten, the Ace counts as either 1 or 11, and all other cards count as their face value. Suits are of no significance. If the Players initial card is an Ace, it is considered a "Blackjack" which is paid even money. When both the Dealer and Players initial card is an Ace, this will constitute a push.

BONUS BET

One Card Blackjack also features an optional Bonus Bet wager. This wager will be paid at odds of 10 to 1 if the player's initial card dealt is an Ace.
