PLAYING THE GAME

HOW TO PLAY

Sic Bo is a popular casino game played with 3 six-sided dice in a sealed container. Players place bets on various outcomes of the dice rolls. The dice are "shaken" or "rolled" using an electronic device or by the dealer in a dice shaker.

The game offers a range of betting options, from betting on specific numbers to wagering on the total sum of three dice. The goal is to predict the outcome of the dice roll by placing bets on the table.

Each player can make one of many bets on the table with payout odds ranging from even money to 180 to 1. Players make their bets by putting their chips on the specific bet they want to make indicated by an image of dice. Each bet must be completely within the designated betting area. Once players have placed their wagers the dealer will announce "No more bets," the dealer will then remove the cover and announce the numeric value of each die. The value of each die will be entered into the keypad and the table will illuminate winning betting areas. Areas not illuminated will be collected as non-winning wagers.

PERMISSIBLE WAGERS:

TRIPLE (SPECIFIC):

All 3 die show the same number, and the player selected that number to appear on all 3 dice. Even money.

ANY TRIPLE:

All 3 die show the same number, and the player wagered that any of the number 1 through 6 would appear.

DOUBLE:

2 die show the same number and the player selected that number to appear on 2 out of 3 dice.

DOMINO – TWO DICE COMBO:

Any 2 of the 3 dice match the 2 numeric values that were wagered as a combination.

For example, a roll of 1,2,3 will pay the following DOMINO combinations: "1,2", "1,3", and "2,3"

TOTAL VALUE BET:

Wins if the numeric total of all 3 dice equals the total of the number wagered.

SMALL BET:

Wins if the total of all 3 dice is 4-10. This bet loses on any TRIPLE.

BIG BET:

Wins if the total of all 3 dice is 11-17. This bet loses on any TRIPLE.

ONE OF A KIND:

Wins if one or more of the 3 dice show the number wagered.
