

HOW TO PLAY THREE CARD DRAW POKER

YOUR GUIDE TO PLAYING
CASINO TABLE GAMES

PLAYING THE GAME

Standard rules of 3 Card Poker apply for this exciting fast paced game.

/ HOW IT WORKS

1. Player places an Ante wager to receive their first 3 cards. Player may place an optional Double Shot Bonus wager that pays additional higher odds on good hands.

2. Each player in turn, has one of three options to play their hand:

- Fold their hand whereby losing their Ante wager and optional Double Shot Bonus wager, or;
- Place a Play wager in an equal amount to their Ante wager to stay in the game (no card drawn), or;
- Place a Draw wager in an equal amount to their Ante wager, whereby players can discard one of their 3 cards and receive a new card from the dealer.

3. After all player decisions have been made, the dealer will reveal their 3 cards. If the dealer has a pair or better they will stand pat.

If the dealer does not have a pair or better, they draw one card and make the best 3-card hand from the four cards.

4. The dealer will compare the house hand with the player's hand and resolve wagers as per standard 3 Card Poker rankings.

5. Player wins both the Ante and Play/Draw wagers if they beat the dealer, otherwise they lose both bets.

6. If the player and dealer tie, both the Ante and Play/Draw wagers will result in a push.

7. Bonuses on a final hand of Straight or better are paid on the Play/Draw wagers regardless of the outcome of the hand, as follows:

Hand	First 3 Cards	Draw
Mini- Royal	20 to 1	10 to 1
Straight Flush	5 to 1	4 to 1
3 of a Kind	4 to 1	3 to 1
Straight	2 to 1	1 to 1

Optional Double Shot Bonus Wager pays:

Hand	First 3 Cards	Draw
Mini- Royal	60 to 1	20 to 1
Straight Flush	40 to 1	6 to 1
3 of a Kind	30 to 1	4 to 1
Straight	5 to 1	Loss
Flush	3 to 1	Loss
Pair*	1 to 1	Loss

* The player will still be paid 1 to 1 on a pair in the first 3 cards if they draw and do not get 3 of a kind. The player will not be paid if they draw into a pair.

PLAYERS' EDGE Must be at least 21 years old to play Slots, Table Games or to receive Seminole Wild Card benefits. Must be 18 or older to play Bingo and Live Poker. Persons who have been trespassed or banned by the Seminole Tribe of Florida or those who have opted into the self-exclusion program are not eligible.
